Federal law requires that the following shall be considered in project prioritization:

- All Projects must be eligible for federal aid funding and ready to obligate funds within timeline outlined in law
- Priority given to projects in economically distressed areas (EDAs) as required by law
- Priority given to projects whose expenses will be completed in three years, by February 17, 2012
- All funds required to be obligated by March 2, 2010.
- Maximize job creation and economic benefit
